5. _____ Two letters of recommendation submitted by persons other than relatives, in a sealed envelope: One must be from a guidance counselor/college advisor or school faculty member and the other from an organization representative for community/volunteer service.
6. _____ Documented evidence of leadership in school, church, and/or volunteer community service in the form of a reference letter, a certificate, pictures, etc.
7. _____ An essay with a minimum of 500 words (typed, double spaced, and 12-point font). Please use a cover page for your essay. Do not write your name on the essay. The review committee would like the authors of the essays anonymous to ensure integrity throughout the review process.
